

Moebius syndrome is a rare neurological disorder. People with Moebius typically cannot smile, frown, or move their eyes laterally. Many also have limb abnormalities or club feet. It is estimated that 1 to 20 per 1 million people have Moebius syndrome. The cause is unknown. Other symptoms include articulation and speech disorders, no blinking of the eyes, and strabismus (crossed eyes).
