What is Moebius syndrome?

People with Moebius typically cannot smile, frown, or move their eyes laterally. Many also have limb abnormalities or club feet. It is estimated that 1 to 20 per 1 million people have Moebius syndrome. The cause is unknown. Other symptoms include articulation and speech disorders, no blinking of the eyes, and strabismus (crossed eyes). Otherwise, we are just like everyone else.
