

REQUEST FOR APPLICATIONS: Grant Proposal to Study Moebius Syndrome and Sleep Disorders

The Moebius Syndrome Foundation (MSF) Grant Program provides seed-money grants to qualified investigators for scientific and/or clinical research. The Moebius Syndrome Foundation has identified a need for additional investigation into the role of Moebius syndrome and sleep disturbances.

A survey of the Moebius syndrome community has identified the following issues with sleep:

- Sleep terrors in children, adolescents, and adults
- Restless legs in children and adults
- Insomnia and tiredness during the day
- Coughing and use of CPAP during sleep

The MSF is looking to fund 1 proposal in 2022 that further investigates the link between Moebius syndrome and sleep disturbance. Applications should include a 5-page study proposal, a budget, and NIH biosketch for each investigator. Applications are due June 1, 2022. The funding request is limited to \$150,000.
